- QUALIFICATIONS:**
1. Satisfactory completion of an accredited training program. Board eligible or Board Certified preferred.
  2. Current license in the State of California as a Family Practice or Internal Medicine.
  3. Demonstrated ability to work effectively with diverse races, ethnicities and ages in a multicultural environment. Bilingual in Spanish/English preferred.
  4. Strong desire to work with underserved population and assist in the development of clinical services that will improve the overall health status of the residents of the Antelope Valley.

- RESPONSIBILITIES:**
1. Examine patients taking medical history, record results and make a preliminary diagnosis or decision on follow-up procedures;
  2. Administer or order diagnostic tests (e.g., X-rays, electrocardiograms and blood work) and interpret test results;
  3. Perform preventive and therapeutic procedures (e.g. immunizations, injections, suturing, wound care and management of infection);
  4. Exercise professional judgment regarding consultation with the Medical Director concerning appropriate treatment;
  5. Develop and implement patient care plans, instruct and counsel patients, and record progress;
  6. Prescribe medications to the extent allowable by state guidelines and clinic regulations;
  7. Provide general health education regarding matters such as proper diet, family planning, emotional problems of daily living and health maintenance;
  8. Provide oversight for Family Nurse Practitioners and/or Physician Assistants
  9. Work with Medical Director to update protocols annually.
  10. Seek staff privileges at local Hospitals, but limited IP care.
  11. Participate in on-call rotation.
  12. Participate in and follow Quality Improvements guidelines and projects.
  13. Prescreen cases requiring review by the Medical Director;
  14. Utilize specialist and make referrals as required.
  15. Participate in staff meetings, planning meetings and other meetings, as needed.
  16. Participate in Provider and other Clinical Staff meetings
  17. Willingness to utilize Electronic Medical Records
