RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provides primary care treatment in accordance to standard medical practice protocols.
- Records medical history and provides physical examinations and follow-up care.
- Provides individual patient instruction in accordance to prescribe treatment plan.
- Prescribes appropriate medication to patients as needed according to medical protocols and standard medical practice.
- Identifies physical, nutritional and/or lifestyle problems and refers to appropriate on-site and off-site resources.
- Identifies psychological and emotional problems/issues and refers to on-site or off-site resources.
- Consults with Medical Director or specialty physicians for patient evaluations as needed.
- In conjunction with Medical Director, updates Medical Protocols on an annual basis.
- Adheres to Quality Improvement guidelines and participates in Quality Improvement programs for chronic diseases.
- Supervises mid-level practitioners as assigned.
- Works closely with Nutritionists/Health Educators in order to provide appropriate education to the patients.
- Participates in Provider meetings and QI Meetings as required.
- Serves as a preceptor instructor to Nurse Practitioner, Physician Assistant, or medical students assigned.
- Attends conferences and seminars when requested and complies with continuing education requirements.
- Provides trainings to Nurse Practitioners, Physician Assistants and other clinic staff, on periodic basis.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Satisfactory completion of an accredited training program.
- Current license in the State of California as a Family Medicine physician, board certified or board eligible.
- Current CPR
- Must relate well to all cultural and ethnic groups in the community.
- Bi-lingual English/Spanish (preferred but not required)
